Philadelphia Christmas Parade Guidelines

You will NOT be allowed to travel south on Poplar Avenue prior to the parade!

1. Please do not park on private property without the property owner's permission!!! You are also not allowed to park at Philadelphia High School!
2. **NO RACING 4-WHEELERS ALLOWED:** a group may use "one" 4-wheeler to pull a trailer.
3. The parade route will start on Poplar Avenue, turn West on Main Street, North on Byrd Avenue, East on Beacon, then North on Church and West again on Myrtle. The parade will end at Philadelphia High School.
4. **The parade will begin at 6:00 p.m. Please be in the line-up no later than 5:00 p.m. as entries will be pre-judged. Winners will be announced and awards given as you pass the stage.**
5. No bikes.
6. There is a \$10 fee for each entry.
7. Please do not throw candy at the crowds.
8. Please do not pass anything to the crowd from your vehicle.
9. Please **do not use a Santa Claus in your entry** since an "official" Santa will arrive at the end of the parade.
10. Wagons are allowed if a responsible person (ages 13 and up) pulls the wagon.
11. You must have your **line-up number** and name of your organization on your entry where it is visible from both sides or across the back of the entry. If you do not have your number, you will not be judged.
12. Spacing: please stay no less than 20 feet from the entry in front of you. No one wants to see gaps in the parade.
13. When traveling to the parade, please carpool as much as possible. Coordinate these arrangements ahead of time to help everyone line-up on time.
14. All units with small children participating in the parade shall be accompanied by a responsible adult.
